VIRGINIA


To honor the bicentennial of the United States Constitution a series of stamps and postal cards were created and will be issued over a five-year period from 1987 to 1992.

This commemorative postage stamp was issued June 25, 1988, on the 200th anniversary of the ratification of the United States Constitution by the state of Virginia. It is the thirteenth issue in the United States Postal Service Constitution Series.

From its founding, Virginia has played a prominent role in American history influencing the Revolutionary War Movement, the development of our nation's government, the Civil War, and today's political and social structure. Eight U.S. presidents have called Virginia home.

Constitution Commemorative Series

This commemorative postage stamp was issued 200 years after Maryland's overwhelming endorsement of the Constitution in 1788 on February 15, 1988, to honor the anniversary of the seventh state ratification of our nation's blueprint. It is the tenth issue in the United States Postal Service Constitution Series.

Maryland boasts of quiet, magnificent forests, mountains, seashores, and fertile farmland. It represents a wealth of natural, human, and technological resources. Nestled along the Atlantic coast, Maryland cuts across the Chesapeake Bay just above the nation's capital.

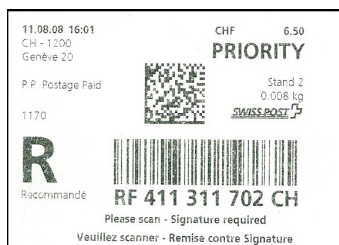

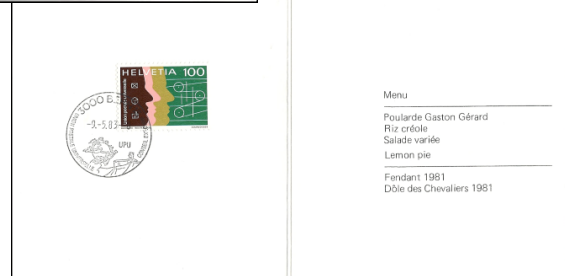


Special Cover for FD of Session, Registered, 28 Apr. 1983

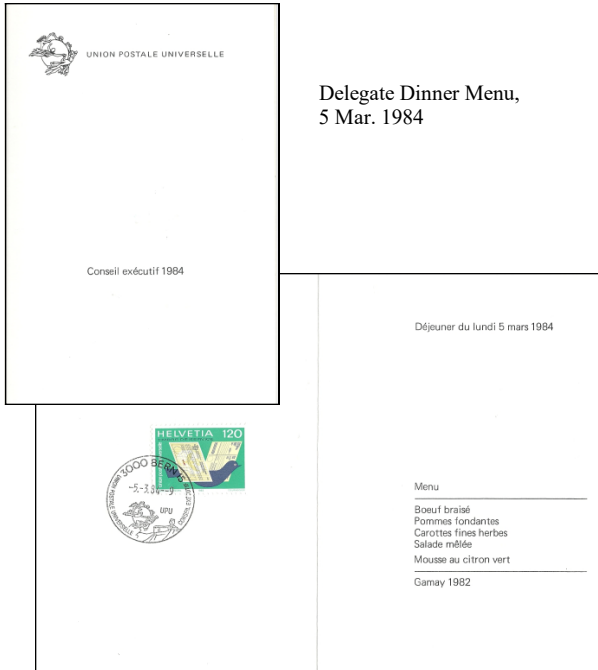


Registered Philatelic cover (on EC CC), 29 Feb. 1984

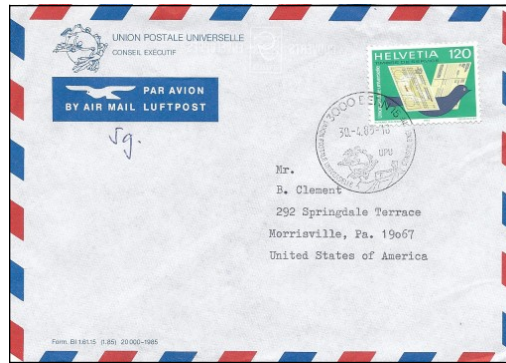
